

GRADUATION INFORMATION – 2017

The 2017 commencement exercises of Christendom Graduate School are scheduled for Saturday, 5 August, at the Front Royal campus. Every graduate is expected to attend the graduation ceremony unless he/she is prevented by a serious reason. We will have a Mass in Christ the King Chapel at 11:30 am, immediately followed by the conferral of degrees. After the ceremonies, there is a graduation luncheon/brunch for graduates, faculty, family, and friends. Graduates may bring as many guests as they wish, but there will be a \$10 charge for every guest beyond two for the luncheon. We will contact you later about other details.

Each graduate must pay a graduation fee of \$100 whether attending the commencement exercises or not. Graduates attending the commencement exercises must wear academic garb consisting of gown, cap, and the master's hood. Members of religious orders may wear their habits instead of the gown, but they need the master's hood if they are receiving the MA degree. **The graduation fee, your name as you wish it to appear on your diploma(s), and your order for rental of academic garb must be received at the grad school by May 1, 2017. Local students will be notified when the academic garb arrives so they may pick it up at Christendom Graduate School and iron it if they wish; distance students can get theirs just before the ceremony. Please return your garb immediately after the ceremony.
