† Students concentrating in sacred Scripture are exempt from the core OT and NT requirements. In lieu of these, they take two additional concentration-specific courses.

** Competency in Latin is also required for the moral theology and systematic theology concentrations. Language courses do not count towards the 42 credits needed for the MA degree. Please see bulletin for details.

‡ Competency in Greek (or another biblical language) is also required for the Sacred Scripture concentration. Language courses do not count towards the 42 credits needed for the MA degree. Please see bulletin for details.
